
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

The name of the Society will be "GUJARMAL MODI CHARITABLE"TRUST" herein after referred to as the "TRUST SOCIETY"

SIII. Registered Office

Registered Office of the Trust The Society shall be at a Modinagar, I Distt. Ghaziabad, U. P. or at such other place in India as the Board of MyTrustees may decide.

III. Objects & Enabling . Powers

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS.

A SOCIETY UNDER SOCIETIES RESISTRATION ACT, XXI OF 1860 All the mandatory provisions of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (Act XXI of 1860), will apply.

Definitions.

In the Memorandum of Association, Rules & Regulations, and Bye-laws of the Trust Society, the following words and expressions shall have the following meanings unless repugnent to the subject of the context :

- The 'Trust Society' means 'Gujarmal Modi Charitable Trust.
- ii) The 'Act' means the Societies Registration Act 1860 (Act XXI of 1860).
- 111) 'Board of Trustees' means the Board of Trustees for the time being of the Trust Society as constituted or reconstituted pursuant to Rules and Regulations of the Trust Society.
- iv) 'These Prosents' means Memorandum of Association, Rules & Regulations and Bye-Laws of the Trust Society.

'Chairman' means the Chairman for the time being of the Trust Society.

vi) 'Vice Chairman' means the Vice Chairman for time being of the Trust Society.

vii) 'Secretary' means the Secretary for the time being of the Trust Society.

Every subscriber to the Momorandum of Association of the Trust Society and every person, whose name is entered in the Register of Members under a resolution of the Board of Trustees shall be a Member of the Trust Society, and shall continue to be such Member until he dies, or resigns or becomes disqualified, as provided hereunder.

A Member shall be deemed to have become discuslified if and when in the opinion of the Members of the Board of Trustees or a majority thereof :

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- 1) he becomes of unsound mind, or
- ii) commits an act, which makes it undersirable to let him continue as a Member such as monattendance in three consecutive meetings of the Trust Society without sufficient cause, or

    - Acquiring by purchase or lease of on ownership pasis or in exchange, hire or otherwise any immovable property of any tenure, including leaseholds in any part of India and the acquisition of Leason's or

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other rights in property ;

- vii) Any investments which the Holding Trustees may by law be authorised to make for the investments of Trust Society ;
- (3) The Folding Trustees shall be at limberty to erect or build upon the vacant land acquired by ow belonging to the Trust Society, buildings, or structures out of funds of the Trust Society and to let out such buildings or structures on such terms and conditions and subject to such rent, compensation, fees, conve nants and agreements as the Holding Trustees may deem fit.
- (C) The Holding Trustees shell have the power to borrow or raise any monies and to enter into such agreements, assurances deeds and things in relation thereto whether by way of pleage, hypothecation, charge or mort-mage of the whole or any part of the movable or immovable properties comprised in the funds of the Trust Society on such terms and conditions as the Holding Trustees may deem fit, and to secure repayment of the moneies borrowed or raised.

The Holding Trustees shall be entitled to vote themselves or through their authorised representatives in respect of any share of securities held upon the Trust Society in such manner as the Trustees may think best fit for the benefit of the Wrost-Society.

The Holding Trustees shall have powers to delegate all or any of its powers specified in this clause to the Board of Trustees or to the Executive Committee as the Holding Trustees may in their discretion deem fit.

Municipality/ Local body or any person whatsoever and to obtain from such Government or authority Municipality or Local body any rights, priviledges or concessions, that the Board of Trustee may deem necessary or desirable to obtain for attainment of the above objects and to carry out, emercise and comply with such arrangements, rights, priviledges and concessions and corresponding duties attached thereto.
- (d) It shall be lawful for the Board of Trustees to establish and support or aid provident fund or any other funds, and to grant pensions, allowances, gratuities and to make payments towards insurance for the employees of the Trust Society.

The Board of Trustees shall have the power to subscribe or guarantee moneys for charitable or other benevolent object or institutions or for any exhibitions or for any public public, general or useful object.

It shall be lawful for the Board of Trustees to acquire by purchase or to take on lease or on ownership basis or otherwise lands, buildings and movable an immovable properties end subjects to the approval of the Holding Trustees to construct, build or erect building houses or tenements, pull down, renovate, maintain, rebuild, alter, adapt, improve add to, develop or repair any immovable properties comprised the fund of the Trust Society and to expand for all or any of the above purpose, such moneys out of the fund of the Trust Society or the income thereof as the Board of Trustees may think fat and proper.

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(g) The Board of Trustees shall be entitled in the name of such of its member or members as it may nominate to become members of any co-operative society or other like institutions for the protection, benefit and improvement of the fund of the Trust Society or any property of the Trust Society as also to enter into such contracts and take such other actions and proceedings for the purpose of such protection benefit or improvement and to pay all fees and subscriptions and defray all costs, charges and expenses as may be considered proper. The Board of Trustees shall also be entitled to enter into any egreement or convenants (including restrictive covenants) with the owner of or persons interested in any other properties comprised in the fund of the Trust Society or such other properties as they may deem fit from time to time.

The Board of Trustees shall have the (h) power to insure any premises comprised in the fund of the Trust Society against loss by fire, lightening, earth-quake, civil commotion or other risks or lesses of whatsoever nature as the Board of Trustees may think proper from time to

time.

The Board of Trustees shall have the power to pay all rents, rates, taxes and other outgoings and expenses from time to time.

The Board of Trustees shall have the power to set aside from time to time such sums or moneys as the Board of Trustees may consider proper, to meet the expenses of heavy repairs or by way of depreciation or sinking fund and to utilise the same and the income thereof for heavy repairs or for rebuilding or reinstating immovable properties or erecting new buildings.

- (k) It shall be lawful for the Board of Trustees to permit any immovable property forming part of the fund of Trust Society to be held, used and enjoyed for the objects and purposes of the said Trust society.
- (1) The Board of Trustees shall be at liberty to form one or more committees consisting of themselves or one or more of them and such other person or persons as they may think fit to co-opt from time to time for the purpose of any particular activity and to fix the remuneration (if any) of the members (including any Trustee or Trustees) of such committees. The Trustees shall be entitled to frame the constitution of such committee and also to frame rules and regulations for the Management and conduct of the meetings of such committees provided such rules and regulation still not be inconsistent with or contrary to these presents. The Trustees shall be entitled to delegate to such committees such powers as they may consider proper and desirable and which can be delegated by law for proper administration of the Trust Society. In exercise of these powers the Trustees shall be guided by any statutory or administrative requirements of the concerned authority.

The Board of Trustee Shall have the power to delegate all or any of its powers listed out in this clause to the Executive Committee.

Subject to the supervision or control by the Board of Trustees and subject to these presents, the Executive Committee shall carry on the Management and Administration of the activities of the Trust Ecciety for and on behelf of the Trust Society and shall have the power to spend out of the fund of the Trust Society such amount as may be

required in that behelf and shall also perform

13. Powers & Duties of the Executive Comm-

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the duties for the furtherance of the objects of the first Society and exercise the powers which may from time to time be assigned to, vested in or delegated to the Executive Committee by the Board of Trustees or by the rules and regulations to be framed by the Board of Trustees as hereinafter mentioned.

- 14. Meetings of Holding Trustees/Board of Frustees Executive Committee.
- Meetings of the Polding Trustees and of the Board of Trustees and of the Executive Committee shall be held in such manner and within such period as may be prescribed by the rules and regulations.
  - ii) Save as otherwise provided in these

    Rules, any three members shall form a

    quorum at a meeting of the Holding

    Trustees and Four members at a Meeting

    of Board of Trustees and Three members

    at a meeting of the Executive Committee.
  - iii) Except in emergent situation, a notice of not less than three days shall be given for such meetings.

Any Business which may be necessary for the Holding Trustees, soard of Trustees or Executive Committee to transact urgently may be transacted by circulation among all its members them in India and any resolutions circulated and approved by majority of the members signing the circular shall be as effectual and binding as if such resolution had been passed at a meeting of the Holding Trustees, Board of Trustees of Executive Committee respectively.

General Meeting of the members of the Trust Society shall be either Annual General Meetings or Epecial General Meetings.

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- ii) Anrmal General Meeting : An Annual General Meeting shall be held as far as possible within six months of the close of each financial year at such date, time and place as the Board of Trustees may decide, provided that not more than 18 months time shall elapse between any two Annual General Meetings. The Ordimary business of the Annual General Meeting shall be :-
  - To receive and consider the Annual a) report of the Board of Trustees on the working and effairs of the Trust Society in the past year.
  - To receive and consider the Annual b) Accounts for the preceding year ;
  - To elect the members of the Board of Trustees, in place of retiring Trustees, if any ;
  - To appoint Auditors and determine their remuneration; and
  - e) To consider any other business that the Board of Trustees may place before the Armual General Meeting

iii) Special General Meeting: All General Meetings other than Annual General Meeting shall be called special General Mesting. The Board of Erustees may convene a special general meeting when ever it thinks fit, but upon a requisition signed by one-fourth of the number of members of the Trust Fociety, being deposited at the Registered Office of the Trust Society, it shall forthwith call a special General Meeting, Each such requisition shall specify the purpose for which the Meeting is requisitioned. To other business shall be considered at such a Meeting. If the Board of Trustees does not, within thirty days from the date of deposit of a valid requisition, proceed to call such a meeting on a day not later than 60 days from the date of deposit of the

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requisition, the meeting may be called by the requisitionists by themselves or atleast 50% of them.

- Notice of Annual General Meetings: Subject to any requirements of these presents a notice of not less than 14 clear days shall be given for the Annual any General meeting, and no business other than that stated in the notice shall be transacted in the meeting except when it is deemed a matter of extreme urgency and it is permitted by the Chairman.
- Quorum : At every General Meeting, v) one sixth of the total number of Members or 5 Members, whichever is less, personally present shall form a quorum. If at any such meeting a quorum is not present within half an hour of the time appointed for the meeting, the meeting, if convened upon the requisition of members, shall stand dissolved, In any other case it shall stand adjourned to the same day in the next week at the same time and place. If at the adjourned meeting also a quorum is not present within half an hour from the time appointed for the meeting, the Members present shall be a quorum.

Adjournment : The Chairman of any General Meeting may, with the consent of the Meeting, adjourn the meeting from time to time and from place to place. No notice need be given of an adjourned meeting unless it be so directed in the resolution of adjournment

vii) Votes of Members : Every Member present in person shall have one vote, All questions shall be decided by a majority of votes of the Members present.

viii | Questions how Decided : Every Question, submitted to a General Meeting shall, save as otherwise provided in these

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presents or in the Act, be decided by a majority of votes to be determined by a show of hands. In case of an equality of votes, the Quairman shall have a second or casting vote.

a) 16. Resolving Dirrerences.

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In case of difference of opinion arising amongst Holding Trustees and in all matters wherein the Holding Trustees shall have a discretionary power, the votes of the majority shall prevail and shell be binding on all the Holding Trustees. PROVIDED, HONEVES, that if the Holding Trustees are equally divided in opinion,

the matter shall be decided according to the casting vote of the Chairman of the Trust Society.

In case of difference of opinion arising from amongst the Board of Trustees and in all matters wherein the Board of Trustees have discretionary powers, the question of difference will be voted on and the majority shall prevail. If the votes are equally divided then the mott will be referred to the Holding Trustet and subject to the provisions of subclause (a) of this clause, the decision of the Holding Trustees shall be binding on the Board of Trustess.

In case of difference of opinion arising amongst the Executive Committee, the question on which the difference has erisen shell be referred to the Board of Trustees and subject to the provisions of sub-clause (a) and sub-clause (b) in this clause, the decision of the Board of Trustees shall be binding on the Executive Committee.

Board of Trustees or the Executive Computtee is vacated as contemplated in clause 6 & 7 respectively or in any other manner, the remaining Holding Trustees, Soard of Trustees or members of the Executive Committee shall until such time as the vacancy or vacancies

If the office of a Holding Trustee or the

is or are filled be entitled to exercise all the powers whether discretionary or otherwise vested in the Holding Trustees, Board of Trustees and the Executive Committee, and during such period the provisions of these presents shall govern the remaining Holding Trustees, Board of Trustees and the Executive Committee so far as the same are applicable.

18. Minutes & Accounts.

The Executive Committee through the Secretary shall keep or cause to be kept Minutes of all the meetings of the Holding Trustees, Board of Trustees, Executive Committee and Members of the Trust Society, also proper books of accounts. The Accounts shall be Audited annually by a Chartered Accountant as Auditors to be appointed by the Board of Trustees.

19. Bank - Accounts.

from time to time to open, operate and Meintain a banking account or accounts in the
name of the said Trust Society at such bank
or banks as the Committee may decide. The
account or accounts may be operated by Two
such Members of the Executive Committee joint
ly as the Executive Committee may from time
to time decide who may at any time pay or
cause to be paid or withdraw any moneies
forming part of the Trust Society fund or
the income thereof:

provided THAT any one person authorised by the Executive Committee from time to time may deposit moneys to the credit of any such account or accounts either by way of fixed deposit or current account or safe custody was account or any other account whatsoever.

The receipt issued by a person duly arthorises by the Executive Committee or the Board of Trustees or the Holding Trustees for receiving the income of the Trust society, securities, other documents or any momeys or property forming part of fund of the Trust Society or received by the Trust Society shall be sufficient and shall effectually discharge the person or persons paying, giving or transferring the same from being bound to see the application or being answerable for the loss,

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mis-application or non-application thereof. The Board of Trustees by a resolution may also authorise any bank to collect any interest, dividend or income of the Trust Society Fund on its behalf.

Trust Society Staff.

The Executive Committee may from time to time appoint temporarily or permanently and remove Joint/Assistant Secretaries Treasurers, Officers, supervisors, clerks and other employees of the Trust Society as the Swecutive Committee may deek expendient and fix their remuneration and the terms and conditions of their employment. The Board of Trustoes shall, however, have power to foundand maintain provident fund, gratuity fund, pension and other funds for any amployees of the Trust Society and make rules and regulations (with the power to add, alter, smend, Vary or substitute the same or any of them) regarding the payment thereof.

PROVIDED THAT such rules and regulations shall not be in conflict with or inconsistent with these presents.

22. Agents :

The Executive Committee shall have the power in its discretion, to employ and pay any agent (including banks) to do any act whatsoever in relation to the said Trust Society including receipt and payment of money without the Executive Committee being liable for loss thereof.

23. Deposits of Securities, Documents etc. with-Bank

> Capital and Inc-

cone.

The Executive Committee may deposit by way of custody any documents or Securities held by the Trust Society relating to any property belonging to the said Trust society with any Benk or Benker and may pay any sum payable in respect of such deposit.

The spard of Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of this Trust Society be considered as capital or income and whether, out of the capital or

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income any expenses or outgoings or application thereof for any of the purposes authorised by these presents shall or lought to be paid or borne:

provided DAMT nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorise the Board of Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Fund of the Trust society for any object or purpose hot authorised by these presents.

25. Trustees! Responsible

The Holding Trustees or the members of the Board of Trustees or the members of the Executive Committee as the case may be shall be respectively chargeable only for such fund of the Trust Society and income including money, stocks, funds, Sheres and Securities as they shall actually receive notwithstanding their respectively signing any receipt for the sake of conformity and shall be answerable and accountable only for their own acts, receipts, neglects or defaults and not for those of the other or others of them min for and banker, broker, auctioneer or agent or any other persons with whom or into whose hands any Trust Society fund or Trust Society income may be deposited or come nor for the insufficiency or deficiency of any stocks, funds, shares or securities nor for any other loss unless the same shall happen through their own wilful default or dishonesty respectively.

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26 Alteration of Memorandum of Association.

The Trust society may elter the provisions of the Memorandum of Association so as to alter its name or its objects, by adopting the procedure prescriped for the purpose in Societies Registration act & Rules made there under as applicable to the Trust Society.

29. Alteration of Rules & Regulations

The Rules and Regulations of the Trust
Society may be altered by a Resolution passed;
at a special General Meetings of the Trust
Society, called for the purpose, by a three
fifth majority of the members present and
voting.

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28. 'INDEMNITY: Every member of the Board of Trustees or eny other persons employed by the Trust Society or Auditors of the Trust Society, shall be indemnified out of the funds of the Trust Society against all losses and expenses incurred by him in our about the discharge of his duties in defending any proceedings, civil or criminal, in which judgement is giver - in his favour, or in which he is acquitted or in any other manner, except such as happened from his own wilful default. No.member of the Board of Trustee or other officer shall be liable for any other member of the Board of Trustee or Officer, or for joining in any act or receipt, or for act of conformity, or for loss occurring to the Trust Society unless it shall be due to his own wilful default.

29. Interpretation.

The Hoard of Trustees shall be the sole authority for the interpretation of these presents, and the decision of the Board of Trustee on any question of interpretation or upon any matter affecting the Trust Society and not provided by these presents shall be final and binding on the Members.

30. Dissolution. If on the winding up or dissolution of the Trust Society there shall remain, after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be peld to or distributed among the members of the Trust Society be dealt with in such manner as the Trust Society may determine, provided, however, that the assets be used in such manner as to further as nearly as possible the objects, for which the Trust

> Society was established. Upon such resolution of the Trust Society its assets will be transferred to a registered Society with

similar objects.

31. Miscellaneous.

- (a) Every year list of members of the Board of Trustees shall be filed in the office of the Registrat of Societies, Eucknow as required under Section 4 of Societies Registration Act.
- (b) This Trust Society may sue or be sued in the name of Secretary.

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
